

Trondhjemsridtet 1919 – Rally 2024

with start Saturday 8. June 2024 @ 09:00

Arrival, Parking and Start



Start from the Armed Forces Aircraft museum (Forsvarets Flysamling), Museumsvegen 35, 2060 Gardermoen.

Time schedule

- Registration at “Check-in” in the lobby of Park-In Hotel on arrival. Check-in is open Friday evening 6:00-9:00 PM and Saturday morning until 8:00 AM.
- Riders Briefing @ Park-In Hotel on Saturday 8. June from 08:00-08:40.
Remember to appear in full riding gear!

- **Rally start from 09:00** according to Starting list. **Remember COLD start!**

Arrival and parking

- **Upon arrival** please report yourself and any passengers to “**Check-in**” in the lobby of Park-In Hotel at Museumsvegen 25, 2060 Gardermoen. Please follow the instructions given by the staff regarding parking etc.
- At **Check-in** you will receive a start-number to be attached to your bike and a pendant ID-badge for riders and passengers. The ID-badge identifies the participants at coffee and lunch stops and should be worn at all times. Marking-tags for luggage to be sent with the luggage-van are also given.
- **Parking** is free and without charge. Parking is available on the grounds of the Aircraft museum as well as the on hotel parking lot, marked P1-P5 on the map on page 1. P1 are best suited for cars with trailers, camper vans and larger vehicles. P2 and P3 are suitable for cars and vans. P4 is a reserve parking lot, to be used if P1-P3 becomes full. Parking is at your own risk, there is no security guard.
- Any luggage not carried on the bike can be delivered to the rally luggage van marked **green X** on the map. ***Note! Oil and petrol are not accepted in luggage van. It is important that you mark your luggage with start number and name. Luggage tags are given at Check-in. The luggage must be delivered no later than 15 min. before start - applies to all days.***

START

- Remark! The rally has a “**Cold start**” policy. From 08:50 and until your start you should not run your engine. *(This to reduce noise and thus enhance verbal communication at start, also spectators can enjoy the exhaust note of the starting bikes rather than a loud buzz).*
- **Start commences @ 09:00 SHARP.** The riders start continuously according to the start list. The riders line up in ascending start number order in the **Start line-up** area – see map. Please advance incrementally towards the start portal. Start your engine when the preceding rider has been given signal to start.

Security on route:

- If you should become cold, tired or not confident that you are able to continue safely: stop and call the Serviceteam. We will pick you up and forward you and your mount by car.

- By stop/breakdown: Call the Serviceteam, see list below.

Finish

Tuesday 11. June 2024 at the Armed Forces Aircraft museum (same place as Start).

Finish line

- Ride straight up through the Finish-portal and stop there. You will receive the rally badge, the rally is officially finished and you are free to load up and leave.
- Luggage is handed out consecutively from the Luggage-van on arrival.
- There is no debriefing after the rally, see you in 2026!
